

RESPONSE

Should an armed assailant/active threat occur on campus, LLUH will implement an emergency lockdown to secure the campus. Emergency lockdown is recognized as a best practice to ensure personal safety and facilitate a rapid response by law enforcement.

LLUH endorses the "Run, Hide, Fight" tactical response endorsed by the Department of Homeland Security for staff and students if confronted with an armed assailant or active shooter.

Emergency Procedures Emergency Lockdown

Upon receiving emergency

- x Close curtains or blinds and turn off lights
- x Silence phones and other electronic devices
- x

Avoid calling 911 or Security Control Center unless you have an immediate emergency to provide information on the location of shooter(s) or victims

- x Remain in emergency lockdown until room is cleared by uniformed law enforcement/security or emergency lockdown order is lifted by LLUH Alerts emergency notification

Consider alternatives for those unable to effect emergency lockdown:

- x Non-ambulatory patients in beds – cover with sheet, close privacy curtains, close doors to rooms
- x Units without lockable rooms – barricade or block main entrances with beds, chairs, equipment
- x Evacuate to another floor with securable space if possible

Run, Hide, Fight

If confronted with an armed assailant or active shooter or there is evidence of an assailant or active shooter nearby (e.g., you hear gunshots), implement the most appropriate personal protective actions following the “Run, Hide, Fight” model:

RUN: If possible, run away from the threat. Identify potential escape routes leading away from the threat. Use cover and concealment as needed. Avoid running in large groups of people that can become easy targets. Continue running until the area of attack is no longer in sight. If a secure space is found where lockdown can be implemented and when safe to do so, report the assailant/active shooter to 911 or Security Control Center; provide location and number of assailants, if known.

HIDE : Individuals who find themselves in a situation where they cannot safely exit the area should hide where they are. Be quiet, silence all electronic devices, turn off lights, and lock the door if possible. If not possible to lock the door, barricade the door and hide out of sight. Grab any objects that can be used as a self-defense tool. Do not open the door for anybody even if they state they are Law Enforcement. LLUH Alerts will provide notification when emergency lockdown has been lifted or an “all clear” announcement has been made.

FIGHT : If there is insufficient time to RUN or HIDE, or an assailant breaches a space used for emergency lockdown, employees and students are encouraged to fight for their lives with improvised self-defense weapons such as fire extinguishers, flashlights, staplers, or office furniture. Focus attack on areas related to sight and balance (e.g., eyes, neck, head). Fighting an assailant is a last ditch effort. Often RUN and HIDE are not possible.

Department

Security Department personnel shall comply promptly and fully with the instructions of law enforcement personnel when attempting to resolve a hostage or active shooter incident.

Procedures
