Degree Program	 Degree programs regularly have special/unique: Admissions Content/curriculum Diploma 50% difference in curriculum/courses between degree programs Impact on transcript: Degree noted on transcript
	Impact on diploma:Degree noted on diploma
Concentration	 Curriculum/content must have at least 20% difference in curriculum/courses between other programs in these areas: Courses, practicum, and/or research Must have enough qualified faculty (according to professional accreditation standards) to teach/guide a concentration Must have appropriate clinical practice sites, if applicable Impact on transcript: Concentration may be noted on transcript depending on program's needs Impact on diploma: Concentration may be noted on diploma depending on program's needs
Specialization	 Adds to the concentration Impact on transcript: Specialization <i>not</i> noted on transcript Impact on diploma: Specialization <i>not</i> noted on diploma
